Subject: Living Arrangements for the School year 20-21.

The Pullman Fire Prevention Office recognizes the issue associated with the Covid-19 and living arrangements in all of the fraternity and sorority houses. Social isolation is a problem in houses where students share a sleeping porch.

We are prepared to offer all of the houses to allow students to sleep in their day/study rooms to achieve some social isolation. In allowing this time limited situation we only ask that each house install "stand alone" (individual, not tied to other) smoke detectors in each room. Also stand alone carbon dioxide detectors in the hallways outside of these day/study rooms. This is only allowed for this school year.

I understand you have a meeting with a lot of the house managers coming up in July. Could you please share this information with the managers.
